RE: Flint Hills MPO Roadway Functional Classification Updates

Dear Mr. Spicer:

The Flint Hills Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) has updated the Function Class map for the City of Manhattan, KS to reflect the requested changes to College Avenue. As can be seen in the attached map, College Avenue from Claflin Road to College Heights Road has been downgraded from a Major Collector to a Minor Collector. All other changes approved by the MPO's Policy Board at the May 17, 2023 meeting are maintained. The MPO is requesting KDOT's approval and for the document to be forwarded on to FHWA and FTA for their concurrence.

These updates were based upon meetings with local jurisdictions and their staffs in public works and planning. Changes, while minimal, better reflect current traffic rates and travel patterns. In addition, the western Pottawatomie County map outlines several segments that are proposed for future classification based on planned growth.

Maps of the recommended changes are attached to this letter. Additionally, GIS shapefiles are available upon request.
