2. Public Comment Opportunity

3. Staff Updates

- Jared Tremblay noted the following
 - US-24 Corridor study will be discussed as the FHMPO will be presenting at the City-County-County meeting on Feb. 20th. The outcome of that meeting will dictate how the region moves forward
 - TIP Amendment #6 projects are due back to the FHMPO by Friday Feb. 10th

4. KDOT Update

- Ryne Dowling stated he will be sending a TIP project update for a Big Lakes capital project bus.

8. ACTION ITEM: Recommend approval of Mobility Performance Measures (PM 3)

9. DISCUSSION ITEM: Transportation Demand Model (TDM) Scenario Results

- Jared Tremblay presented on the results of the TDM future scenarios. He noted population trends, and the issue with fitting projected growth into the region despite a decade of stagnation. He then went over the E+C, Modernization, and Expansion scenarios, and the Level of Service (LOS) maps for each.
- Karen Becker asked about having a more detailed discussion on the topic with City staff.
